ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 30 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF BERKELEY LAKE TO PROVIDE FOR A DEFINITION OF LIVESTOCK; TO PROHIBIT BREEDING PENS AND LIVESTOCK; TO REPEAL CONFLICTING LAWS; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Be it Ordained by the Council of the City of Berkeley Lake that the Code of Ordinances of the City of Berkeley Lake, Georgia, is hereby amended by adding the definition of "livestock" under Section 3-101, and by adding a new Section 3-302 and renumbering the current Section 30-302 "Enforcement" as Section 30-303, as follows:

3-101. Definitions

Livestock means and includes horses, cows, goats, pigs, sheep or any other four-legged animal, excluding dogs and cats, kept for pleasure or profit. Fowl are expressly included within this definition.

3-302. Breeding pens and livestock prohibited.

It shall be unlawful for any person to keep or maintain within the limits of the city any breeding pens of any type or any livestock.

All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are repealed to the extent of any such conflict.

This ordinance shall be effective upon approval by the Council.
